

Email received from County Council Highways and Transport, District Lead Officer, 20<sup>th</sup> October 2022.

Response to a request for barriers and signs to enable a temporary road closure during the Remembrance Service on Sunday, 13<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

*"We believe that the green area has previously been closed off as attached. Historically, this was facilitated by [REDACTED] the highways maintenance team [REDACTED] and the arrangement probably does not follow up to date guidance and requirements. There is a closure on the main B road but traffic diverts around the green area for a short distance.*

*This type of closure should really be supported under Town Police Clauses Act legislation which can be requested from Lancaster City Council. As far as we are aware, no current fee application would be required and more information is available on their website. [Road closures - Lancaster City Council](#)*

*In future, the County Council will not be able to drop signs and cones to individuals who are not accredited to carry out works on the highway of this nature and this is not a commitment that we can make in future as we would have to provide this service for all towns and villages, which is not sustainable.*

*What we will do this year is look to make sure that the necessary arrangements are put in place through one of the TM contractors. I can now confirm that Ventbrook TM will provide the closure on 13 November and your details have been passed to them as a point of contact. We will cover the cost in this final instance given the short lead in times and in support of your Remembrance service."*
