On the 18th day of December 2023 Lancashire County Council confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the area, by recording bridleway from a junction with Nether Kellet Road passing through Kirk House Farm in a generally easterly direction then along a field edge to be crossed by Footpath 1-24-FP13 and then continuing east-north-east along the field edge to a field gate. The route then continues as a bounded track known as Sands Lane and is crossed by a further footpath (1-24-FP 10) to a junction with an access track, turning north-north-east through to an open junction with Kirkby Lonsdale Road.

The total length of the route is 0.78 km and the width varies between 3m and 8m.

The Order took effect on the 18 December 2023, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or that any of the requirements of Schedule 15 to the Act have not been complied with in relation to the Order, he may, under Paragraph 12 of Schedule 15 to the Act, within 42 days from the date of publication of this Notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
